The IJRR is a research-oriented program that manages the care of the majority of patients having joint replacement surgery at Washington Hospital. The perioperative care follows a set of research protocols, which are continuously adjusted based on our current research to achieve the most reliable outcomes. There is no additional cost to patients for their participation in the research activities of the IJRR.

Patients having joint replacement surgery at Washington Hospital outside of the IJRR also receive excellent care, but are not managed under the IJRR research umbrella. Since non-IJRR surgical patients do not have the same surgical methods or perioperative management protocols employed, they are not managed on the same inpatient unit as the IJRR patients to avoid confusion and streamline the care of both patient groups.
